Prayer and much thought have been poured into our protocol and plan for re-entering church property. Church leaders have sought to consider every angle of worship for YOUR safety and well-being. Here are our guidelines for *Outdoor Worship*:

- ✓ Upon arrival, someone will direct you to a parking place. Do not park on the East side.
- ✓ *If you are ill*, have a fever, dry cough, or any COVID-19 symptoms, please seek medical help and *refrain from coming to worship* until you are well.
- ✓ Please wear a *mask* as an indication of your love for your sisters and brothers in Christ.
- ✓ Sit in *indicated seating* in shady area of parking lot and lawn. **Please sit in family groups, 6 ft. apart from others.** *Bring your own CHAIR or blanket, and umbrella* for protection from the sun. You might want to wear sunscreen.
- ✓ **Offering** will be taken by persons wearing masks and gloves. Please have your offering ready.
- ✓ We ask that you *not* mingle or approach each other. **Please maintain social distancing.**
- ✓ If you are over age 65 or have health concerns the CDC suggests you remain home. We love you dearly and do not want you to become a statistic of this virus.
- ✓ When worship ends, please stay seated and you will be **dismissed to your cars** in a manner that protects us all.
- ✓ We plan to simulcast on Zoom and Facebook Live. Please be patient with us if this technology does not work. We may need to record the service and post on Facebook later in the day or have a second service on Zoom and Facebook Live. We will do the best we can.
- ✓ Did you know that if you have free long distance on your cell phone you can join Zoom worship? Please contact Phyllis Goodyear for access info: 317-902-7641.
- ✓ Please watch for email, text or phone call should weather cause us to cancel outdoor worship. You may not be notified until Sunday morning. If we cancel, we will worship on Zoom and Facebook Live.
